Cold & drafty home? For renters too!




- FREE home energy assessments
- Low- and no-cost programs to insulate and seal air leaks in the home for income-eligible households (see back)

Need help with heating?

- Income-eligible households may qualify for free heating system repair and replacement.
- Significant incentives are available for heat pumps, which often cost less to operate than fuel oil, propane or electric resistance heat.

Savings with solar

- Signing up for community solar can reduce your monthly electric bill by 5 to 20%.
