

**TOWN OF BALDWIN
TOWN BOARD MEETING
APRIL 13, 2022**

THIS REGULAR MEETING of the Town of Baldwin was held at the Town of Baldwin Town Hall and called to order at approximately 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Purvis. Those present were Councilman Conklin, Councilman Smith and Councilman Collins. Councilwoman Purvis was absent.

Also present were Faith Marmor, Robin Rosekrans, Paul Tillotson and Anna Pirro.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Robin Rosekrans stated that on Decker Road, the seasonal piece, there is a lot of trash and tires that people dropped off. Councilman Conklin commented that the guy on the bottom of Hogback has property up there and he cleaned the tires and trash out of the woods and put it on the side of the road hoping that the town or someone would pick them up.

COUNTY LEGISLATURE

The County Legislature was not in attendance and no report was given.

MINUTES

A Motion was made to accept the March 9, 2022 Town Board Meeting Minutes by Councilman Smith, seconded by Councilman Collins, All Ayes.

SUPERVISOR

We received a reimbursement check in the amount of \$1,138.00 from Comp Alliance for the Safe Workplace Award for its performance during policy year 2021.

We received a letter from Impact Power Solutions regarding solar projects in which the company will pay up to four times more than what can be earned farming or running your land for crops. This is open to anyone that has property suitable. Faith Marmor will place this letter on the town's website.

Chemung County will be having a Ukraine Supply Drive. This information can be found on their website.

We received a letter from Frontier with emergency contact numbers. Faith Marmor will place this letter on the town's website.

At the April 6th Town Supervisor's Meeting with Chris Moss, it was stated that sales tax revenue is way up. This last year was a really good sales tax income year.

HIGHWAY

The Highway Department changed all equipment oil and filters for this summer.

They started working on Elston Hollow Road. They have installed a 4' pipe, 50' long, and replaced four other cross pipes throughout the road and 3 driveway pipes. They were going to start putting gravel on the road Monday the 18th but Vestal could not make it.

Potholes were filled again today.

Due to fuel and electric prices going up in the Budget (\$6,100.00-Highway) for the buildings, Paul Tillotson has \$1,900.00 for the rest of the year. Last month on fuel for equipment was \$3,900.00 and we are just coming in to the busy season. He talked with Faith Marmor and she is either going to run out or be very close to her Budget as well. Supervisor Purvis to contact Barb Harding to have her attend the May Town Board Meeting.

Chips is looking to be between \$195,000.00 and \$225,000.00 so we should be good for that account.


