TOWN BOARD MEETING
MAY 11, 2022**

THIS REGULAR MEETING of the Town of Baldwin was held at the Town of Baldwin Town Hall and called to order at approximately 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Purvis. Those present were Councilman Smith, Councilwoman Purvis and Councilman Collins. Councilman Conklin was absent.

Also present were Faith Marmor, Robin Rosekrans, Paul Tillotson, Barb Harding and Anna Pirro.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Robin Rosekrans asked if we received the second payment for COVID funds concerning the Haefele expansion. We have not yet received these funds. She asked what the status was of the yearly reports and Barb Harding stated that she is on year 2019.

COUNTY LEGISLATURE

The County Legislature was not in attendance and no report was given.

MINUTES

A Motion was made to accept the April 13, 2022 Town Board Meeting Minutes by Councilwoman Purvis, seconded by Councilman Smith, All Ayes.

We received a Notice from NYSEG with contact information as to questions regarding anything dealing with NYSEG. This notice was given to Paul Tillotson.

We received a Notice from Christopher Moss regarding Chemung County Finances being on solid ground because of the Sales Tax Revenue going up from \$24.5 million to \$44.9 million from the last three years. The percentage is going up for the Town of Baldwin.

A Notice from Windstream was received that they are ending services as of August 2, 2022. Verizon and Haefele were suggested for landline phones. Supervisor Purvis will contact Haefele regarding same. Faith Marmor will contact Betty Jo Ziemer as to the Town Hall landline phones/carrier.

HIGHWAY

Elston Hollow has been graded and oiled, and they have started hauling in stone for stone and oil.

Hug, Hardscrabble and Herrington roads, as well as the other side of town, have been graded.

The Highway Department has started putting down dust control, had a problem with truck from Vestal.

Last meeting it was mentioned that the Propane and Electric Account was low. There is currently \$944.77 left in that account.

The Highway Department hopes to have all roads graded by the end of May if weather lets them.

EXECUTIVE SESSION


The Board did not go into Executive Session.
