

**TOWN OF BALDWIN
TOWN BOARD MEETING
DECEMBER 13, 2023**

THIS REGULAR MEETING of the Town of Baldwin was held at the Town of Baldwin Town Hall and called to order at approximately 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Purvis. Those present were Councilwoman Purvis, Councilman Smith, Councilman Collins and Councilman Conklin.

Also present were Paul Tillotson, Anna Pirro, Faith Marmor, Robin Rosekrans, Zebulin Wolcott, Kayla Wagner (NYMIR) and Joe Donovan.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

LEGISLATURE

Mr. Donovan stated that the Budget was passed. The County is in pretty good shape all-in-all. There will be a little more money available for next year as it was not all used up this year. If the town would like to get pricing on some dumpsters and estimate on the tonnage, for a week's use, for people in the town to bring things/have a town cleanup, this can be paid for out of this money. He will remind the town when the application comes due. The term limits passed for the Legislature and this takes effect 1/01/24. There is going to be about \$100,000.00 to split between Baldwin and Erin to help finish up internet in the towns. He will follow up with the County after the first of the year on this issue.

SUPERVISOR *(report attached in addition to these Minutes)*

He had a phone meeting today with Chris Moss regarding the Highway funding for the County. We are going to be getting \$91,600.00. Paul Tillotson will need to do a specific project with forecast amounts and the current road budget. They will be sending a form this next week to be completed.

We received a notice from Haefele that they will be removing the YES Network from their channel lineup effective 1/01/24 and basic cable will decrease by \$4.00 per month. The retention tier will increase by \$2.10 per month and digital basic will increase by \$.50 per month effective 1/01/24. Local station fees will increase as of 1/01/24 per negotiated contracts. While they do not know the exact station fee

increases yet, they will only pass along the exact amount charged to them without additional increases from Haefele TV.

The Yates County Legislature, Carlie Chilson, is pushing to get the Citizen's Audit of the Election, Voter Registration rolls in the State because they have discovered a lot of discrepancies.

EXECUTIVE SESSION


The Board did not go into Executive Session.
