

**TOWN OF BALDWIN
TOWN BOARD MEETING
JULY 10, 2024**

THIS MONTHLY MEETING of the Town of Baldwin was held at the Town of Baldwin Town Hall and called to order at approximately 6:00 p.m. by Supervisor Purvis. Those present were Councilwoman Purvis, Councilman Wolcott, Councilman Smith and Councilman Collins.

Also present were Faith Marmor, Paul Tillotson, Anna Pirro, Joe Donovan and Robin Rosekrans.

A MOMENT OF SILENCE WAS HELD FOR GERRY TILLOTSON WHO RECENTLY PASSED AWAY.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Robin Rosekrans - She asked the Town Clerk what the requirements are for when a Town Board meeting is rescheduled, is it two weeks or a month it is supposed to be posted as to whether it has been changed or not? Faith Marmor replied that she does not think so because there is not even a two week notice for a regular meeting. If there is a Special Meeting that is different, but if it is a regular meeting she believes it just has to be confirmed with the board members and there just has to be a couple days notice. The information was placed on the Town Hall door/entrance and on the town's website she believes a week in advance.

Joshua Smith - Requested the status of the ATV Law. Supervisor Purvis stated that he has contacted the prior Town Attorney and asked that all documents be sent to the current Town Attorney. He will check to see if this has been done.

LEGISLATURE

The County Legislature handed out free Chemung County Fair General Admission tickets with dates 7/31/24 through 8/03/24. The Fire Department and the Town Clerk/Town Hall has these tickets available to residents.

MINUTES

A Motion was made to accept the 6/10/24 Town Board Meeting Minutes with no changes by Councilwoman Purvis, seconded by Councilman Smith, All Ayes.

We received a letter from County Legislature Moss's Office with confirmation of the County continuing to share sales tax collections. The Town rate for 2025 and 2026 will be 34.55%.

TOWN CLERK

The Town Clerk report is attached to these Minutes. 2025 Budget inquiries will be sent in August.

HIGHWAY

The Highway Report is attached to these Minutes.

A copy of the fully executed Soil and Water Municipal Agreement was received. The last page shows an increase of 5% per year. We used to be able to get equipment to do what work was needed inside the town but now it is only mainly used for streams, anything with creeks, they will come in and do it - we cannot use the equipment any longer for anything else. On this note, the town needs to think about renting a piece of machinery to keep doing road work like what was done on Lockwood Run opening up and making more passable. Bradco for a monthly rental is \$5,800.00 and for a weekly rental is \$1,800.00. Austin is \$5,300.00 for a monthly rental and \$1,700.00 for a weekly rental. Chips money can be used if using the equipment for a Chip's project. This is something the Board is going to have to think on and Paul Tillotson will bring this to the Board for approval once equipment is needed.

EXECUTIVE SESSION


The Board did not go into Executive Session.
