THIS MONTHLY MEETING of the Town of Baldwin was held at the Town of Baldwin Town Hall and called to order by Supervisor Purvis. Those present were Councilwoman Purvis, Councilman Wolcott, Councilman Smith and Councilman Collins.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

The Reniff Road property owner asked when the Reniff Road Bridge would be reopened. Paul Tillotson stated that the soonest would be mid-September. The property owner was also concerned with emergency response if needed. Paul Tillotson has spoken with all emergency response, county and school authorities regarding this issue.

LEGISLATURE

There is nothing new except taxes and fighting over the Arena. He has not heard anything regarding the Casella money and expects this information time frame to be March or April of 2025. Sales tax revenue is close to the same dollar amount as last year and sales tax shares will then be close to the same as last year for towns. Monies from the County for internet for rural communities still needing additional help has not yet been given and he will contact Moss regarding this matter. There has been talks regarding consolidation of towns.

EXECUTIVE SESSION


The Board did not go into Executive Session.
