THIS MONTHLY MEETING of the Town of Baldwin was held at the Town of Baldwin Town Hall and called to order by Supervisor Purvis. Those present were Councilwoman Purvis, Councilman Wolcott and Councilman Smith. Councilman Collins was absent.

Also in attendance were Faith Marmor, Paul Tillotson, Robin Rosekrans, Joe Donovan and Barbara Kelly.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

There were no public comments.

LEGISLATURE

The ARP money that was set aside for Baldwin and Erin is in a freeze at the moment. The Casella money is available for the town itself and community only.

MINUTES

A Motion was made to accept the 5/14/2025 Town Board Meeting Minutes with no changes by Councilman Wolcott, seconded by Councilman Smith, All Ayes.

TOWN SUPERVISOR

The Supervisor report is attached to these Minutes.

We received notice of the town's non-compliance for the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund. Barb Harding is currently working on this matter. Haefele's total construction cost was \$52,715.19 and the town may have to pay back the remaining money not used/may have to pay back the difference. There are two places on Norway Road that may be a possibility for using the remainder of the money towards.

We received a check for \$887.00 from Comp Alliance for the Safe Workplace Award. Councilman Wolcott would like to possibly use this check towards something for the HW Department personnel as the Board had discussed this last year and spoke of a Town of Baldwin winter jacket as a possibility. He will look into this matter.

2026 HEALTH INSURANCE DISCUSSION - Barbara Kelly from InsureOne handed out a Benefit Guide given for 2025 (current plan) and a proposal packet. Currently the town is utilizing low, averaging 10% since 2021, for the HRA. The proposed increase for 2026 is a little over 16%. The town's current plan seems to be the best plan available at this time. There will be a small increase for Dental/Vision, she believes 8%.

MARTIN JERZAK CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER RESIGNATION - A Motion was made in the form of a Resolution No. 23-2025 (6R-2025) to accept Martin Jerzak's Resignation as Code Enforcement Officer for

the Town of Baldwin effective June 27, 2025 by Councilwoman Purvis, seconded by Councilman Smith, All Ayes. A copy of the written Resignation is attached to these minutes.

PAYMENT OF BILLS - A Motion was made to pay the General Bills for May 2025 No. 84-99 in the amount of \$8,622.81 by Councilman Smith, seconded by Councilman Wolcott, All Ayes. A Motion was made to pay the Highway Bills for May 2025 No. 73-85 in the amount of \$17,870.22 by Councilman Smith, seconded by Councilman Wolcott, All Ayes.

Robin Rosekrans asked where the town was with the yearly finance reports. Supervisor Purvis will request this information from Barb Harding.
