

AS OF MARCH 18, 2020, THE GOVERNOR HAS ORDERED THAT ALL TOWNS REMAIN CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE AND THAT ALL ACTIVITY BE CUT BY 50%. THEREFORE, THE TOWN OF BALDWIN WILL NOT BE HOLDING MONTHLY TOWN BOARD MEETINGS, THERE WILL BE NO OFFICE HOURS – OFFICIALS/EMPLOYEES ARE TO ONLY DO WHAT HAS TO BE DONE, WHAT IS NECESSARY, THE TOWN CLERK WILL BE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY AND WILL NOT HOLD REGULAR OFFICE HOURS.

THE TOWN CLERK WILL BE CHECKING PHONE CALLS, EMAILS, THE LOCK BOX OUTSIDE OF THE TOWN HALL DOOR AND THE MAIL ON A DAILY BASIS. ANY AND ALL DOG LICENSES AND MATTERS THAT CAN BE HANDLED VIA EMAIL OR THROUGH DROP OFF IN THE LOCK BOX OUTSIDE OF THE TOWN HALL DOOR ARE TO BE HANDLED THIS WAY UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

ALL EMPLOYEES/OFFICIALS ARE TO LEAVE AT LEAST A 6 FOOT DISTANCE BETWEEN ANY AND ALL PERSONS AND ELIMINATE ALL UNNECESSARY CONTACT WITH THE PUBLIC.
